This training creates dialogue on what it means to be an adult ally for LGBTQ youth by informing participants' LGBTQ terminology, the process of "coming out" as LGBTQ, and a discussion of the challenges LGBTQ youth face in their homes, schools, and communities.

HOW TO SUPPORT LGBTQ YOUTH

This interactive training provides an overview of suicide among LGBTQ youth, the different environmental stressors that contribute to heightened suicide risk, & practical steps for reducing the risk of suicide & promoting resilience in all young people.
